WHEREAS, The *Draft Compact for a Sustainable Bay Area* is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 011685 , which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Commission on the Environment adopted Resolution 008-01-COE on July 16, 2001 endorsing the *Draft Compact for a Sustainable Bay Area*; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors joins the overall goal of stakeholder organizations and civic leaders regarding a new shared local vision rooted in common values about how the region can be more sustainable; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors strongly endorses regional planning and the spirit of the *Draft Compact for a Sustainable Bay Area*; and, be it
