6 WHEREAS, The Elections Task Force is given responsibility by the San Francisco  
7 Charter Sec. 13.110 for redrawing the district lines for San Francisco’s Supervisorial Districts;

9 WHEREAS, The Elections Task Force is charged by the charter to redraw the district  
10 lines in accordance with criteria including keeping recognized neighborhoods intact and  
11 reflecting communities of interest within the city and county; now, therefore, be it

12 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Elections Task Force to redraw  
13 the district lines using the principle of “maximum continuity,” meaning that the locations and  
14 character of the existing supervisorial districts shall be preserved as much as possible.




