10 WHEREAS, The electorate of the City and County of San Francisco passed
11 Proposition J in November, 1976 adding Section 8.300-1 to the Charter allowing City
12 Departments to contract with private companies for specific services which can be practically
13 performed for a lower cost than similar work by City and county employees; and

14 WHEREAS, The Director of Administrative Services has previously sought and
15 received approval of the Board of Supervisors to contract with the Moscone Joint Venture
16 under the provision of Proposition J and now wishes to fund the contract for the management,
17 operation and maintenance services for 2002-03; and,

18 WHEREAS, The Controller has certified on June 6, 2002 that said services can be
19 performed at a lower cost to the City than by employees of the City and County; now,
20 therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors hereby concurs, retroactively, with the
22 Controller’s certification and approval that the Director of Administrative Services may contract
23 for management, operation and maintenance services for Bill Graham Civic Auditorium and
24 the Moscone Center.


