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3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH), to**  
4 **accept retroactively and expend a grant in the amount of \$99,350 from the Centers for**  
5 **Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) to analyze pedestrian injury patterns and**  
6 **evaluate the effectiveness of countermeasures and to enter into an agreement for the**  
7 **use of these funds; for the period of September 1, 2003, to August 31, 2004.**

9 WHEREAS, SFDPH has applied for and been awarded a grant from CDC in the  
10 amount of \$99,350 to analyze pedestrian injury patterns and evaluate the effectiveness of  
11 countermeasures; and,

12 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, CDC requires the City to enter  
13 into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of  
14 Supervisors in File No. 031810, which is hereby declared to be a part of this  
15 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

16 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$5,584; and,

17 WHEREAS, This Resolution requires expedited review by the Board of Supervisors  
18 because we did not receive the grant award notice until August 29, 2003; and,

19 WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds  
20 may be placed automatically on the consent agendas in committee, as they are usually  
21 considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure  
22 of grant funding; now, therefore, be it

23 RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept retroactively and expend a  
24 grant in the amount of \$99,350 from CDC; and, be it

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FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend the grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10-170-1; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it


FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when the agreement expires.


