7 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors passed Ordinance No. 14-03, file No. 021815  
8 which was amended by the Board on 1/13/03, prohibiting departments from publishing hard  
9 copies of annual reports without prior approval by the Board of Supervisors; and,

10 WHEREAS, The Emergency Communications Department's mission is to field  
11 emergency 911 calls in the City and County and dispatch the appropriate police, fire/EMS or  
12 other Emergency Services resources; and,

13 WHEREAS, The Emergency Communications Department's dispatchers receive and  
14 process about 1.6 million phone calls per year, making it one of the busiest 911/OES centers  
15 in the country; and,

16 WHEREAS, The Emergency Communications Department's Consolidated Emergency  
17 Communications Center is a model for the country, and is visited by many local cities,  
18 counties, states and foreign countries each year; and,

19 WHEREAS, The Emergency Communications Department is producing its first Annual  
20 Report with a goal of summarizing the Department's services and programs, highlighting  
21 achievements of the prior year that the Department wishes to include and presented in terms  
22 and format accessible to the average citizen; and,

23 WHEREAS, The Emergency Communications Department feels it would be beneficial  
24 to maintain a minimal number of hard copies of the report for public distribution through the  
25 Department and the San Francisco Public Library; and,

WHEREAS, The Emergency Communications Department proposes to spend not more than \$1000 in reproduction costs to produce not more than 100 hard copies; now therefore be it


