8 currently metered parking with yellow zone status; and

9 WHEREAS, The Bernal heights Neighborhood Center, a non-profit organization
10 dedicated to the improvement of the Bernal Heights Neighborhood, conducted a survey of the
11 merchants of the 3200 block of Mission Street and ascertained that businesses located on the
12 3200 block seldom used the of metered yellow zone parking outside of their establishments;

14 WHEREAS, The businesses located on the 3200 block of Mission, Tiffany Gardens
15 Development Corporation, Al's Good Food Café and a Touch of Class Beauty Salon, further
16 expressed the desire to convert the yellow zone metered parking to regular metered parking
17 for the convenience of their clients and customers ; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
19 hereby urges the Department of Parking and Traffic to convert parking spaces located at 3286
20 and 3290 Mission Street from metered yellow zones to standard metered parking..




