Resolution urging support for "Hearts in San Francisco", a temporary public art installation.

WHEREAS, "Hearts in San Francisco" will be a city wide public art event debuting in the spring of 2004; and,

WHEREAS, The intent is for "Hearts in San Francisco" to become a unique hybrid of fund-raising, compassionate community involvement and a positive nurturing of artistic expression in a time when it is sorely needed; and,

WHEREAS, The "Hearts in San Francisco" project is designed to be a charity benefit for the San Francisco General Hospital; and,

WHEREAS, San Francisco General Hospital provides a full complement of inpatient, outpatient, emergency, skilled nursing, diagnostic, mental health and rehabilitation services for adults and children, it is the largest acute inpatient and rehabilitation hospital for psychiatric patients in the City; and,

WHEREAS, San Francisco General Hospital is the only acute hospital in San Francisco that provides twenty-four hour psychiatric emergency services and operates the only Level 1 Trauma Center for 1.5 million residents in San Francisco and Northern San Mateo County; and,

WHEREAS, "Hearts in San Francisco" will support tourism in San Francisco, will become a recreational destination for Bay Area residents of all ages, and will raise awareness of issues related to the work of the charity beneficiary; and,

WHEREAS, The "hearts" will be displayed throughout the city – on the sidewalks, plazas, businesses, parks and street corners of San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, the approximately 130 local and nationally recognized artists will reflect the diversity of San Francisco; and,
