WHEREAS, June 19<sup>th</sup> is the oldest known celebration of the ending of slavery; and, WHEREAS, the ending of slavery was announced on June 19<sup>th</sup>, 1865, in Galveston Island, Texas, when Union Major General Gordon Granger announced freedom for all slaves in the Southwest, the last major vestige of slavery following the Civil War; and.

WHEREAS, this occasion occurred more than two and a half years after the Emancipation Proclamation was signed and enforced by President Abraham Lincoln; and,

WHEREAS, the Juneteenth Celebration is now a worldwide celebration since its inception 54 years ago; and,

WHEREAS, Juneteenth is presently a state holiday in Texas, Oklahoma, Florida, Delaware, Alaska, Idaho and Iowa and efforts are continuing to establish Juneteenth as a National Holiday in America; and,

WHEREAS, Juneteenth provides an opportunity for ALL Americans to learn more about our common past and to better understand the experiences that have shaped our nation; and,

WHEREAS, Juneteenth represents the joy of freedom-the chance for a new beginning that allows us to reflect on where we've been, where we're at, and where we're going as one; and.

WHEREAS, Bayview Hunters Point has never had a publicly organized Juneteenth Festival; and,

WHEREAS, Black Diamond Dynasty held the first nonprofit Juneteenth Community
Fair in Bayview Hunters Point from June 12, 2002 to June 16, 2002 allowing the community
to partake in the commemoration and celebration of the signing of the Emancipation
Proclamation; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, the City and County of San Francisco Board of Supervisors urge the Department of Parking and Traffic, Department of Public Works, Police and Fire Department to waive their fees associated with the 2002 Black Diamond Dynasty Juneteenth Celebration.
