Resolution urging Superintendent of the San Francisco Unified School District to convene a meeting in a timely manner with and the San Francisco Board of Education and appropriate City Departments to discuss the progress of the implementation of Proposition "H", the Public Education Fund.

WHEREAS, the voters of the City and County of San Francisco overwhelming passed Proposition H in November of 2004, and

WHEREAS, Proposition "H" directs the San Francisco Unified School District to submit to the Board of Supervisors, no later than six months after the effective date of the passage of the ordinance, proposals for in-kind services that could be provided by the City to the District to further the educational goals and operations of the District and further that the Board of Supervisors shall distribute those proposals to all City departments having expertise in providing or capability to provide such in-kind services, and no later than nine months after the effective date of this measure, the departments will respond to the Board with proposals to provide such in-kind services to the District and further that the School District may use any direct financial support provided to hire consultants to help identify possible in-kind services and further that the Board of Supervisors may, by ordinance, provide for continuation of this planning process, and

WHEREAS, The ordinance further directs the School District, with the assistance of the City's Department of Public Health, Department of Human Services, and Department of Children, Youth, and Their Families, to conduct an assessment of health, counseling, social work, and nutritional needs of pupils in the District; and

1 WHEREAS, No later than February 1 of each year during the term of this measure, the
2 San Francisco Unified School District and the First Five Commission shall each submit an
3 expenditure plan for funding to be received from the Public Education Enrichment Fund for the
4 upcoming fiscal year and further that the proposed expenditure plans include prior year total
5 budgeted and expended appropriations and Fund budgeted and expended appropriations by
6 category, as well as average daily attendance information for the prior year and anticipated
7 average daily attendance information for the plan year, to facilitate multi-year comparison;
now therefore, be it

8 RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors urges Superintendent of the San Francisco
9 Unified School District to convene a meeting in a timely manner with and the San Francisco
10 Board of Education and appropriate City Departments to discuss the progress of the
11 implementation of Proposition "H", the Public Education Fund; and be it
