WHEREAS, Unions and "It's Our Healthcare" are dedicated to promoting these principles for real health care reform in the state of California; now. Therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors supports the joint Labor and It's OUR Healthcare principles developed by a coalition of community, clergy, labor and healthcare organizations and will actively support those goals as a means to achieving affordable, quality health care for all working Californians; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Board of Supervisors will indicate its support for statewide legislation that includes these principles by sending a letter to San Francisco's state legislative delegation urging our representatives to uphold these principles in crafting legislation to ensure that quality health care in California is affordable and accessible to all.
