[Agreement - Workers' Compensation Third Party Administrator Services - Not to Exceed \$26,288,201]

Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency and the Department of Human Resource to <u>retroactively</u> execute an agreement with Intercare Holdings Insurance Services, Inc., for Workers' Compensation Third Party Administrator services for an amount not to exceed \$26,288,201 and for a term of three years from November 1, 2012, through October 31, 2015, with an option to extend the term for up to an additional two years.

WHEREAS, In order to maximize the operational and management efficiency and achieve cost savings to the City, the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) and the Department of Human Resource (DHR) agreed to enter into a joint agreement for the workers' compensation third party administrator services for the City's workers' compensation claims administration services; and

WHEREAS, On February 21, 2012, the SFMTA Board of Directors authorized the Director of Transportation to jointly issue a Request for Proposals for Workers' Compensation Claims Administration Services with the Department of Human Resources, to jointly conduct proposal evaluation, contract negotiation and contract formation for an initial term of three-years with a two-year contract extension option at the City's sole discretion; and

WHEREAS, On April 11, 2012, the City received proposals from TRISTAR Risk Management, Intercare Holdings Insurance Services and Sedgwick Claims Management Services; and

WHEREAS, A selection panel evaluated all three proposals and Intercare Holdings Insurance Services Inc. was selected as the highest ranked proposer; and

WHEREAS, The SFMTA and DHR have negotiated an agreement with Intercare. in the amount of \$26,288,201, with a term of three years, and an option to extend the term for up to two additional years, a copy of which agreement is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 121043; and

WHEREAS, On November 06, 2012, the SFMTA Board of Directors adopted Resolution No. 12-134, recommending approval of the agreement between Intercare and the City and County of San Francisco; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency and the Department of Human Resources to <u>retroactively</u> execute an agreement with Intercare Holdings Insurance Services Inc. for third party administration services for the City's workers' compensation claims, in an amount not to exceed \$26,288,201,for an initial term of three-years from November 1, 2012 through October 31, 2015, with a two-year contract extension option through October 31, 2017 at the City's sole discretion, and, be it

performance metrics for processing claims and collect data on the metrics over the initial three-year contract term with Intercare; 2) evaluate the costs and benefits of contracting for workers' compensation claims administration compared to processing these claims on an inhouse basis prior to exercising the first one-year option to extend the contract from November 1, 2015, through October 31, 2016; and 3) based on the evaluation, determine whether to exercise the one-year option to extend or to perform such services on an in-house basis.
