Projects that require a transportation study typically require analysis of several transportation topics within a geographic area that extends beyond the project block.
- Site Circulation Review fee shall be established at \$9,560 plus time and materials as set forth in Planning Code, Section 350(e). Projects that require site circulation review typically require analysis of a limited, localized analysis of a few transportation topics.

The proposed legislation also clarifies that, in most cases, fees would not exceed 50% of the cost of construction, except that the fee could exceed 50% of construction costs for certain enumerated permits that may have lower construction costs. This change does not alter the amount of the fee, but addresses an apparent inconsistency between the text and the table setting forth the actual fees.
