## \*\*\*SUPERVISOR WALTON'S STATEMENT: SFMTA NOW SECRETLY DUMPING IN DISTRICT 10\*\*\*

**SAN FRANCISCO** – The Mayor's Office, the Department of Emergency Management, the Port and the Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing are once again strong-arming and treating District 10 as a dumping ground for the city's hardest challenges. We already saw the City move the tiny cabins from the Mission to the Jerrold site with zero community input after disregarding the original plans for that location. Now, along with SFMTA, they are secretly trying to quietly trash District 10 again by storing towed RVs at Pier 68 after the Mayor failed to deliver his promise of creating 1,500 shelter beds by this past June.

With the new RV ban going into effect on November 1, instead of having real housing solutions ready, the City is preparing to tow vehicles and hide the problem in District 10 once again. They want to store RVs at Pier 68 with the Port's permission and hope our community does not notice. Zero community input in this process.

When will they stop?! If this plan is so harmless, then put them somewhere else. SFMTA wants the voters' support to fix their budget problems, but our City leadership and departments continue to dump on our neighborhoods without transparency, engagement, or equity. Stop trashing our communities in District 10!
