
Subject: File No. 250449. Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to increase the fees to sell at City-Operated Farmers' Markets and at the Alemany Flea Market.

If this legislation passes, the daily fees to sell at a City Operated Farmers' Market will increase from \$50 to \$60 per day for Certified Producers, and from \$85 to \$100 per day for Vendors. The daily fee per stall for each vendor to sell at the Alemany Flea Market will increase from \$50 to \$60 per day. Beginning with Fiscal Year 2026-2027, the Director of Property shall adjust the fees under this subsection (b)(2) each year, without further action by the Board of Supervisors, to reflect changes in the relevant Consumer Price Index, as determined by the Controller.

In accordance with Administrative Code, Section 67.7-1, persons who are unable to attend the hearing on this matter may submit written comments prior to the time the hearing begins. Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to increase the fees to sell at City-Operated Farmers' Markets and at the Alameda Flea Market. If this legislation passes, the daily fees to sell at a City Operated Farmers' Market will increase from \$50 to \$80 per day. Certified Producers, and from \$85 to \$100 per day for Vendors. The daily fee per stall for each vendor to sell at the Alameda Flea Market will increase from \$50 to \$60 per day, beginning with Fiscal Year 2026-2027. The Director of Property shall adjust the fees under this subsection (b)(2) each year, without further action by the Board of Supervisors, to reflect changes in the relevant Consumer Price Index, as determined by the Controller.
