North Beach denizens being shorted by developer and The City

Neighborhood residents — including fire victims — will suffer from new rebuild plans and SFMTA's transgressions

Special to The Examiner

n 2013, the homes of 32 long-term North Beach tenants went up in flames as the Verdi building on the corner of Columbus and Union burned. Then, on Saint Patrick's Day 2018, the building suffered another tragic fire.

But as our firefighters valiantly fought to extinguish the fire, five small businesses - Coit Liquor, Ferry Plaza Seafood, Tuk Tuk Thai Café, The Salzburg and Rogue Ales Public House — closed forever.

Violetta Persich, a 94-year-old woman from Trieste, Italy, who lived in the Verdi building for 74 years, was displaced after the first fire in 2013.

Another resident, Amandio, was displaced after living in the building for 40 years. After using up his savings over the 3-year waiting period, Amandio was forced to relocate to Los Angeles to live with family when assurances of six-month renovations never materialized.

The Verdi building was a testament to the diversity of North Beach, a United Nations of sorts with residents spanning the spectrum of age, ethnicity and socioeconomic standing. These 32 displaced tenants are holding on to hope that one day they will be able to return home and under The City's rent control laws, all of these tenants deserve that right.

Yet, as time ticks by, the chance of former tenants of the Verdi reclaiming their lives in North Beach dwindles. Despite communicating to residents for years that they would rebuild, the Verdi owners are opting to sell — and now some are calling to demolish the building.

Calls to demolish a historic building in one of San Francisco's most celebrated historic neighborhoods should be met

with skepticism.

North Beach's Verdi building sits next to the neighborhood's living room: Washington Square. The square, an official city landmark, is the oldest of The City's three original parks and remains the only one that is not the roof of a parking garage, as are Portsmouth and Union squares.

The developer of the Verdi building, Jeff Jurow, previously floated plans to replace the structure with a luxury high-rise. That original proposed development disregarded the 40-foot height limit and would have cast a shadow on Washington Square Park.

News of the sale is especially troubling to neighborhood groups who had reached a consensus to support the latest revised project for reconstruction of the building with a restaurant at the roof level, sufficiently set back to avoid casting a shadow

Simultaneously, the SFMTA is forging ahead with expanding the Central Subway to North Beach and Fisherman's Wharf.

This worthwhile effort requires a strong focus on community engagement, fiscal accountability, and lots of federal funding.

Readers might remember SFMTA's Central Subway project to connect Chinatown to South of Market, which was just one project in a long list of the SFMTA's infrastructure blunders coming in over budget and delayed by many years.

The contractor took the SFMTA to the cleaners with constant cost overruns and a never-ending array of change orders, leaving merchants in Chinatown, South of Market and Union Square to suffer mightily during the construction period. The Van Ness BART station also came in years delayed and way over budget, forcing several merchants along the Van Ness corridor to close up shop.

Despite recent statements to the contrary, the Verdi building does not sit on top of a tunnel constructed for the Central Subway. Actually, the tunnel sits a block closer to Filbert and Powell streets,

where the tunnel-boring machines were removed after the historic Pagoda Theater was demolished.

Politics cannot rewrite history. The SFMTA rejected the Columbus and Union location as not feasible after detailed engineering analysis showed it was too constrained and far from the tunnel.

The SFMTA has not made any serious effort to get its financial house in order. It needs to manage future infrastructure projects more vigilantly so these mistakes are not repeated, especially as The City approaches tough budget years.

Last year, the SFMTA, citing impending fiscal straits, had the audacity to propose raising parking-meter rates, extending parking times and charging residents for parking on Sundays.

However, the SFMTA has not offered the public any plans to examine its internal operations. Residents and merchants are looking for leadership and accountability that offer cost savings in the SFMTA's internal operations and infrastructure planning.

Our city owes it to all of us, especially those 32 former tenants of the Verdi building, to keep our financial house in order, preserve our neighborhoods, and protect existing residents.

This is not the time for vanity projects that will take money away from essential services such as hiring police officers, cleaning up our streets and finishing projects that have already started.

San Franciscans deserve accountability and reliability from our government for ourselves and our neighbors. Preservation is more than the protection of historic buildings and neighborhoods — it's the preservation of the lifeblood of The City.
