# SF wants to make it easier to gather in streets

Mayor’s plan would waive fees for outdoor affairs, allow annual permits for vendors

The COVID-19 lockdown a was a long haul for people living in single-room occupancy hotels in Chinatown, particularly for families with children. So, it was like a release valve whistling when the neighborhood staged a Christ-mas street fair in December 2021.

“The whole community was out,” said Lily Ho, president of the Delta Chinatown Initiative, a nonprofit community group that co-sponsored the event. “There were thousands of people, a lot of kids who had been trapped inside.”

“When I remember that day, I think about how transformative a street event can be for an entire community,” said Ho, who continues to volunteer with China-town’s monthly 2024 night markets.

That’s the sort of “excitement and joy” that San Francisco Mayor London Breed is hoping to spread with new legislation

that would waive fees for outdoor affairs such as block parties and street fairs while also simplifying health permitting for special-event food vendors by allowing them to get annual permits instead of requiring individual permits for every event.

“San Francisco is alive when our streets are filled with festivals, markets, and community events,” Breed said in a press release.

The initiative builds on the Mayor’s announce-ment earlier in the week of a new outdoor concert series from May to Octo-ber 2024.

It is the latest in a series of public and private efforts to revitalize The City’s economy by bringing life to its streets through measures such as outdoor visual and performing arts events, as well as legisla-tion that would let cities create outdoor entertainment zones where bars and restaurants can serve alcohol.

The mayor’s legislation targets events that are free and open to the public, oc-cupy three or fewer city blocks, and take place between 8 a.m. and 10 p.m.

Applicants can get up to 12 waivers per year and must be San Francisco-based nonprofits, small businesses, community benefit districts, business improvement districts, or neighborhood or merchant associations.

Fees eligible for waiver include applica-tion, permit and inspection/staffing fees from multiple agencies, including the San Francisco Metropolitan Transportation Agency, Department of Public Health, Fire De-partment, Entertainment Commission and Police Department.

“I’m really excited to see individual communities all over The City develop their own street events,” Ho said.

Manny Yekutieli, the owner of Manny’s SF, a cafe, bar, restaurant and civic events space in the Mission District, called the legislation “bold” and “a game changer.”

Yekutieli started the Civic Joy Fund, a nonprofit that supports activities that bring people together in the streets. The Civic Joy Fund is supporting a new year-long series starting next week. The series will run on the first Thursday of each

month and feature music, dancing, drag performances, food, and retail pop-ups.

Yekutieli said none of the ventures he is currently involved with would qualify for the proposed fee waivers, but he is thrilled that people looking to stage smaller, non-profit events will face fewer obstacles.

“San Franciscans love to gather out-side,” he said. “This is part of the fabric of our culture. Unfortunately, it has become extremely expensive and cumbersome to organize these activations.”

It can cost roughly anywhere between \$500 and \$10,000 to get permits for outdoor events, depending on the size and scope of an event, said The City’s Office of Economic and Workforce Development.

Allen Moy, executive director of the Pacific Coast Farmers’ Market Associ-ation, which operates four markets in San Francisco, said the legislation could save about 25% of the average \$2,700 in annual permit fees that his operation pays for each of its four markets in the Castro, Inner Sunset, Panhandle and Fillmore.

“When our costs go up, we have to pass it on to farmers, who in turn pass it on to customers in the form of higher food prices,” Moy said.

Money saved could fund entertainment and other activities for patrons to enjoy,
