[Appointments, Early Childhood Community Oversight and Advisory Committee - Barbara Ellen Walden and Monique Guidry]

Motion appointing Barbara Ellen Walden (residency requirement waived) and Monique Guidry, terms ending October 8, 2027, to the Early Childhood Community Oversight and Advisory Committee.

MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated person(s) to serve as member(s) of the Office of Early Childhood Community Oversight Committee, pursuant to the provisions of Administrative Code, Article XIII, for the term(s) specified:

Barbara Ellen Walden (residency requirement waived), seat 7, succeeding Monica Walters, term expired, must be a provider of early care and education at a community-based childcare center in San Francisco, but this member cannot be a San Francisco Unified School District provider, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending October 8, 2027;

Monique Guidry, seat 9, succeeding herself, term expired, must be a representative of the Child Care Planning and Advisory Council and nominated to the Board of Supervisors, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending October 8, 2027; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED. That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- The membership of the Early Childhood Community Oversight and Advisory
 Committee has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
- Applicant Barbara Ellen Walden, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a person with experience that uniquely qualifies them to serve on the Early Childhood Community Oversight and Advisory Committee.

- 3. The Early Childhood Community Oversight and Advisory Committee has attempted to fill the position, for which Barbara Ellen Walden was nominated, with an individual who is City a resident and who has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Barbara Ellen Walden is qualified to serve on the Early Childhood Community Oversight and Advisory Committee.
- 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no other possible representatives who is a resident of San Francisco, who has the specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is willing to serve on the Early Childhood Community Oversight and Advisory Committee at this time; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement for Barbara Ellen Walden, as is allowed in cases where no qualified City resident who is willing to serve can be found, pursuant to Charter, Section 4.101(b), that otherwise requires person(s) appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
