13	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
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15	Section 1. Article I of Chapter 10 of the Administrative Code is hereby amended by
16	revising Section 10.20, to read as follows:
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18	SEC. 10.20. BUDGET SAVINGS INCENTIVE FUND
19	(a) Establishment and Purpose of Budget Savings Incentive Fund. The Budget
20	Savings Incentive Fund ("the Fund") is hereby established as a category eight fund for the
21	purpose of encouraging City departments to implement cost-saving strategies and to allow for
22	the reinvestment of those savings in one-time expenditures. Disbursements from the Fund
23	shall be made only to those departments that generated net year-end expenditure savings at
24	the close of the most recent prior fiscal year, as certified by the Controller, and only for the
25	purpose of supporting one-time costs, including but not limited to expenditures that improve

the efficiency of departmental operations, reduce the cost of service delivery, generate
additional revenue, or meet deferred maintenance needs.

- 3 (b) Funding of Budget Savings Incentive Fund. It shall be the policy of the City and 4 County of San Francisco that *a Budget Savings Incentivethe* Fund *will* be annually funded and 5 available by November 1st of each year. At the end of each fiscal year, up to 25% percent of 6 the total appropriation closed to General Fund balance by General Fund departments and the 7 Department of Public Health's hospital funds shall be appropriated into the Fund (the "carry 8 forward amount") and placed on Controller's reserve. The Controller may suspend the carry 9 forward amount in years when the Controller determines that the City's financial condition 10 cannot support deposits into the Fund.
- 11 (c) Request and Approval of Appropriation. Any department funded in whole or in 12 part from the General Fund may submit a request in writing to the Controller's Office for a 13 disbursement from the Fund. Requests shall be reviewed and recommended for funding by a 14 working group comprised of the Mayor's Budget Director, the City Controller, and the 15 President of the Board of Supervisors, or their designees. Recommendations of the working 16 group shall be submitted to the Board of Supervisor's, and the Board may appropriate monies 17 from the Fund by ordinance. Finance Committee for review, and subsequently submitted in the form of 18 a resolution to the Board of Supervisors for approval, until which time the The Controller shall not 19 release the reserve on monies deposited to the Fund until the City has finally enacted such an ordinance. This subsection shall go into effect in fiscal year 2006-2007, provided that year end General 20 21 Fund savings from the preceding year are of an amount sufficient to meet the savings incentive reserve 22 assumptions of the 2006-2007 budget pursuant to the pre-existing Section 3.17 of the Administrative 23 Code. 24

- (d) Upon approval of funding requests, the Controller shall have the authority to
   administratively transfer appropriations from the Fund to the department(s) for which requests
   were approved.
- 4 (e) *Fiscal Years 2020-21 and 2021-22.* Notwithstanding the provisions of subsections (a)
- 5 *through (d), in fiscal years 2020-2021 and 2021-2022, monies in the Fund may be used for any purpose*

6 related to the City's response to the COVID-19 pandemic or the pandemic's economic impacts,

7 provided the use is authorized in the Biennial Appropriations Ordinance or a supplemental

8 *appropriation ordinance. The restrictions on disbursements required by subsection (a), the placement* 

9 of funds on Controller's reserve required by subsection (b), and the procedures for disbursements

10 <u>required by subsections (c) and (d) shall not apply.</u> This subsection (e) shall expire by operation of law

11 *on July 1, 2022, after which the City Attorney shall cause the subsection to be removed from the* 

12 <u>Administrative Code.</u> This ordinance may be amended to suspend the process for making

- 13 appropriations from the Fund, as described in Section 10.20(c), for any single fiscal year to provide for
- 14 *an alternative use of amounts in the Fund.*
- 15 *(f) For fiscal year 2009-2010, the process for making appropriations from the Fund, described*

16 *in Section 10.20(c), is suspended, and all amounts in the Fund on June 30, 2009, shall be deposited into* 

17 *the General Fund to be used to assist in balancing the fiscal year 2009-2010 budget.* 

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Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the
ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

24 Section 3. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors 25 intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,

1	numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipa
2	Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment
3	additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under
4	the official title of the ordinance.
