WHEREAS, Jerry Garcia was born on August 1, 1942, in the Excelsior; and WHEREAS, Over the course of his lifetime, Jerry would become one of the most influential and revered musicians of all time, whose memory continues to unite people in their love of music; and

WHEREAS, Jerry most famously helped find the world-renowned band the Grateful Dead in 1965 and was a musical legend for his guitar playing, singing; and

WHEREAS, Jerry also believed in making music more accessible and giving back to his community, and his memory still brings the neighborhood pride and a sense of camaraderie; and

WHEREAS, In 1994, almost two decades later, the Grateful Dead was admitted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame just a year before Jerry's passing in 1995; and

WHEREAS, Jerry and his bandmates were committed to making music more accessible to the public and transformed their communal house on Ashbury Street into a space dedicated to free concerts for locals; and

WHEREAS, His memory still brings people together through the annual Jerry Day event that takes place every year at the Jerry Garcia Amphitheater in McLaren Park, which also pays homage to the rock legend's Excelsior and San Francisco roots and is a source of pride, community building, community spirit; and

WHEREAS, Jerry Garcia's memory brings music, joy, and inspiration to the current residents of the Excelsior and San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, Harrington Street between Alemany Boulevard and Mission Street marks where Jerry Garcia grew up; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That to honor the legacy and many contributions of Jerry Garcia, there shall be a commemorative street naming of "Jerry Garcia Street" on Harrington Street between Alemany Boulevard and Mission Street; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Department of Public Works is directed to add the honorary street name to its official list of Commemorative Street Names, following the Arts Commission's approval of the design and the Director of Public Works' review of all permit application materials, in accordance with Public Works Code, Section 789 et seq.
