[Grant Agreement Amendment - Five Keys Schools and Programs - Next Door Shelter - Not to Exceed \$32,449,102]

Resolution approving the second amendment to the grant agreement between Five Keys Schools and Programs and the Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing (HSH) to provide emergency shelter operations and services at Next Door Shelter; increasing the grant amount by \$22,736,236 for a total amount of \$32,449,102; and extending the grant agreement term by 36 months, from June 30, 2022, for a total term of December 1, 2020, through June 30, 2025, with five one-year options to extend at the City's sole and absolute discretion; and authorizing HSH to enter into amendments or modifications to the second amendment prior to its final execution by all parties that do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities to the City and are necessary to effectuate the purposes of the grant.

WHEREAS, The Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing's ("HSH") mission is to prevent homelessness when possible and to make homelessness a rare, brief, and one-time experience in the City and County of San Francisco ("the City") through the provision of coordinated, compassionate, and high-quality services; and

WHEREAS, With the enactment of Resolution No. 319-18 in October 2018, the Board of Supervisors and Mayor London Breed declared a shelter crisis and affirmed San Francisco's commitment to a continuum of shelter and service options for people experiencing homelessness; and

WHEREAS, As of the 2019 Point-in-Time Count, there were approximately 8,000 people experiencing homelessness in San Francisco on any given night, 64% of whom were unsheltered; and

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WHEREAS, As part of the Mayor's Homelessness Recovery Plan that was announced in June 2020, the City is committed to maintaining and expanding shelter services; and

WHEREAS, In 2020, HSH selected Five Keys Schools and Programs ("Five Keys") through RFQ #130 to provide emergency shelter services at Next Door Shelter located at 1001 Polk Street for up to 334 adult guests or the adjusted COVID-informed capacity based on public health guidance; and

WHEREAS, HSH executed a grant agreement ("Agreement") with Five Keys for a total grant amount not to exceed \$9,712,866 and a total term of December 1, 2020, through March 31, 2022, a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisor in File No. 220515; and

WHEREAS, HSH executed a no-cost first amendment to the Agreement in 2022 to update the terms and extend the Agreement for an additional three months, for a total term of December 1, 2020, through June 30, 2022, a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 220515; and

WHEREAS, The proposed second amendment ("Amendment") to the Agreement would extend the Agreement by 36 months for Five Keys to continue to provide services until June 30, 2025, and increase the not to exceed amount by \$22,736,236 for a total of \$32,449,102; and

WHEREAS, This amendment requires Board of Supervisors approval under Section 9.118 of the Charter; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the Amendment to increase the grant amount by \$22,736,236 for a total amount not to exceed \$32,449,102 and to extend the grant agreement term for 36 months from June 30, 2022, for a total term of December 1, 2020, through June 30, 2025, with five one-year options to extend at the City's sole and absolute discretion; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That within 30 days of the Amendment being executed by all parties, HSH shall submit to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors a completely executed copy for inclusion in File No. 220515; this requirement and obligation resides with HSH, and is for the purposes of having a complete file only, and in no manner affects the validity of the approved agreement.
