

1 [Apply for, Accept, and Expend Grant - United States Department of Housing and Urban
2 Development - Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS Program Competitive (HOPWA
3 Competitive-CV) - \$159,460]

4 **Resolution approving the CARES Act Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS**
5 **Competitive Coronavirus (HOPWA Competitive-CV) Program; and authorizing the**
6 **Mayor, on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, to apply for, accept, and**
7 **expend the City’s CARES Act HOPWA Competitive-CV Program grant from the United**
8 **States Department of Housing and Urban Development in the amount of \$159,460 for**
9 **the period of July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2023.**

11 WHEREAS, Under the AIDS Housing Opportunity Act, Subtitle D of Title VIII of the
12 National Affordable Housing Act of 1990, Public Law Number 101-625, the City and County of
13 San Francisco is eligible to apply for and receive funds from the Housing Opportunities for
14 Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) Program; and,

15 WHEREAS, The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act),
16 Public Law 116-136, was signed into law on March 27, 2020 to respond to the effects of the
17 public health crisis caused by the COVID-19 pandemic; and

18 WHEREAS, The CARES Act allocated \$65 million in HOPWA Coronavirus (HOPWA-
19 CV) funds to be used to prevent, prepare for, and respond to COVID-19, of which \$10 million
20 shall be allocated to HOPWA competitive awards; and

21 WHEREAS, San Francisco’s received an award letter for a HOPWA Competitive-CV
22 allocation based on the fiscal year 2019 HOPWA competitive award for \$159,460; and

23 WHEREAS, HOPWA Competitive-CV eligible uses include maintaining operations for
24 rental assistance, supportive services, and other necessary actions, to prepare, prevent, and

1 respond to coronavirus, including reimbursement for the costs of eligible activities incurred
2 during the pandemic regardless of date; and

3 WHEREAS, The CARES Act authorizes the Secretary to grant waivers and alternative
4 requirements of statutes and regulations to expedite and facilitate the use of funds to prepare
5 for and respond to COVID-19, including the following flexibilities: may deviate from applicable
6 procurement standards when using these funds to procure goods and services; and, the
7 availability of a 5-day public comment period for amendments to the Consolidated Plan/Action
8 Plan to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus; and

9 WHEREAS, The Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development has
10 prepared programs and a proposed Expenditure Schedule for HOPWA Competitive-CV
11 funding, a copy of which is located in Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. 200618
12 (the "Expenditure Schedule"); and,

13 WHEREAS, The proposed grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance
14 amendment; and,

15 WHEREAS, HUD does not allow use of grant on indirect costs; now, therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, That the Mayor of the City and County of San Francisco is hereby
17 authorized to apply for, accept, and expend the City's HOPWA Competitive-CV award grant
18 from HUD, all in accordance with the purposes and goals for the funding as generally set forth
19 in the 2020-2024 Five Year Consolidated Plan and the Expenditure Schedule; and, be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby approve the
21 purposes and goals for HOPWA Competitive-CV Program funding as set forth in the
22 Expenditure Schedule for recipient agencies and departments; and, be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
24 indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

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1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into and execute
2 agreements between the City and County of San Francisco and the various agencies
3 consistent with the HOPWA Competitive-CV Program and the Expenditure Schedule; and, be
4 it

5 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Mayor is hereby authorized to submit documentation
6 and certifications as may be requested or required by HUD, and to take such additional
7 actions as may be required to apply for, accept and expend the HOPWA Competitive-CV
8 funds consistent with this Resolution and the goals of the HOPWA Competitive-CV Program
9 and all applicable legal requirements, and any such actions are solely intended to further the
10 purposes of this Resolution, and are subject in all respect to the terms of this Resolution, and
11 any such action cannot increase the risk to the City, or require the City to expend any
12 resources, and that the Mayor shall consult with the City Attorney prior to execution and
13 provided that within 30 days of the agreements approved by this Resolution being executed
14 by all parties, such final documents (showing marked changes, if any) shall be provided to the
15 Clerk of the Board, for inclusion in the official file, together with a brief explanation of any
16 actions from the date of the adoption of this Resolution and, be it

17 FURTHER RESOLVED, That all actions heretofore taken by the officers of the City
18 with respect to the application for, or the acceptance or expenditure of, HOPWA Competitive-
19 CV funds as consistent with the documents herein and this Resolution, are hereby approved,
20 confirmed and ratified.
