Resolution declaring July 18, 2025, through August 17, 2025, as South Asian American Heritage Month in the City and County of San Francisco; and affirming the cultural, religious, and linguistic richness within the South Asian community, and recognizing this pluralism as a source of strength that contributes to San Francisco's identity as an open, inclusive, and forward-looking city.

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco is home to a vibrant and growing South Asian community, including both recent immigrants and multi-generational South Asian Americans, with ancestral roots in Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, the Maldives, Nepal, Pakistan, and Sri Lanka, each contributing meaningfully to the city's civic, cultural, and economic fabric; and

WHEREAS, South Asian immigrants and South Asian Americans presence in San Francisco preceded the 1849 Gold Rush, making significant contributions to San Francisco through their leadership and work in small business, technology, education, healthcare, law, arts, transportation, hospitality, public service, and community advocacy and solidarity with other immigrant communities including in times when the U.S. government turned against its own citizens and interned Japanese Americans in concentration camps during World War II; and

WHEREAS, Members of the South Asian community live and work across neighborhoods and districts throughout San Francisco, contributing to the city's economic vitality through small businesses, restaurants, family-run stores, professional services, and innovation-driven industries, while enriching the cultural and civic fabric of the city; and

WHEREAS, The South Asian community has also faced significant challenges, including exclusion under early U.S. immigration laws, racial and religious discrimination, surveillance, and xenophobia, most notably in the early 1900's and the onslaught of structural Islamophobia and broad racist sentiment that followed the attacks of September 11, 2001, which defined an entire era of history, as well as ongoing anti-Sikh and anti-Hindu discrimination that have impacted South Asian communities across lines of faith and identity, yet has continued to organize, build coalitions, and fight for equity, justice, and full civic inclusion; and

WHEREAS, South Asians in San Francisco have been at the forefront of advocacy for immigrant rights, gender equity, LGBTQIA+ representation, workers' protections, amongst other issues, often working across racial, religious, and ethnic lines to build a more inclusive city; and

WHEREAS, This resolution affirms the cultural, religious, and linguistic richness within the South Asian community and recognizes this pluralism as a source of strength that contributes to San Francisco's identity as an open, inclusive, and forward-looking city; and

WHEREAS, The period from July 18, 2025, through August 17, 2025, marks historically significant dates in South Asian history, including the Indian Independence Act (July 18, 1947), the partition of India and Pakistan (August 17, 1947), and the Independence Days of the Maldives (July 26), Bhutan (August 8), Pakistan (August 14), India (August 15), and Afghanistan (August 19), making this month a deeply meaningful time to honor both the histories and continued presence of South Asians in San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, recognizing South Asian American Heritage Month reaffirms the City and County of San Francisco's commitment to honoring the contributions, visibility, and lived experiences of South Asian residents; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors hereby declares July 18, 2025, through August 17, 2025 as South Asian American Heritage Month in the City and County of San Francisco; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board honors the past and present contributions of South Asian immigrants and South Asian Americans and reaffirms its dedication to representation, belonging, and opportunity for all communities in San Francisco.
