WHEREAS, Charter, Section 9.118(a), requires Board of Supervisors' approval by Resolution of any contract which, when entered into, anticipates revenue of \$1,000,000 or more; and

WHEREAS, The proposed agreement contained in File No. 250776, is substantially in final form, with all material terms and conditions included, and only remains to be executed by the parties upon approval of this Resolution; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the agreement in substantially the form contained in File No. 250776; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes DPH to make any modifications to the agreement, prior to its final execution by all parties, that DPH determines, in consultation with the City Attorney, are consistent with this Resolution, in the best interest of the City, do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities of the City, are necessary or advisable to effectuate the purposes of the agreement, and are in compliance with all applicable laws, including City's Charter; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That within 30 days of the agreement being fully executed by all parties, DPH shall submit to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors a completely executed copy for inclusion in File No. 250776; this requirement and obligation resides with the Department and is for purposes of having a complete file only, and in no manner affects the validity of approved agreement.
