WHEREAS, Despite the odds of poor eyesight and missing toes, Claude the Alligator carries himself with grace and welcomes the millions of people that come to visit him every year, impressing them with his consistent weekly training sessions; and

WHEREAS. Claude the Alligator is the only albino alligator with albinism in the history of the California Academy of Sciences and the first alligator to have two children's books make an on-screen appearance at Outside Lands Music Festival; and

WHEREAS, Alligators expected lifespan in the wild is 30 years, but with the help of expert human care, albino alligators can live up to 60-70 years; and

WHEREAS, Claude's impressive 30 years of living represents the importance of sanctuaries for endangered species; and

WHEREAS, The California Academy of Sciences is hosting a public hatch day celebration for Claude the Alligator on Sunday, September 14, 2025, to honor his legacy as San Francisco's famous albino alligator; now, therefore, be it
