Resolution declaring September 15 through October 15, 2025, as "Latin@ Heritage Month" in the City and County of San Francisco to honor and to celebrate the contributions of the Latin@ community.

WHEREAS, Latin@ Heritage Month honors and celebrates the rich history, culture, and importance of the Latin@ community throughout the entire United States, acknowledging their contribution to the fabric of this nation; and

WHEREAS, This celebration begins on September 15 to commemorate the independence from monarchy of several Latin American countries including Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, and Nicaragua. This also includes also includes Mexico's Independence Day on September 16 and Chile's on September 18, making it a month-long event; and

WHEREAS, Latin American countries and cultures have a long history of revolution in the name of equal rights, justice, and equal representation and against the rule of dictatorships which is shared with the history of the United States and our nation's independence from monarchy; and

WHEREAS, Later, Latin@ Heritage Month was born out of the 1960s Civil Rights Movement and continues to symbolize the struggles faced by Latin Americans and their resistance against injustice; and

WHEREAS, Latin@ Heritage Month offers the opportunity for communities, cultural institutions, organizations, schools, businesses, and elected officials to reflect on the enduring spirit of the Latin American fight for independence and the legacy of the Latin@ community on San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco is known as a refuge for the peoples, traditions, arts, languages, cultures, and innovations originating from Latin America; and

WHEREAS, The Latin@ community serves as the backbone of the San Franciso economy, from visiting the City as tourists to working in hospitality, and deserves not just equal rights under the laws of the United States of America, but also due respect and freedom from persecution; and

WHEREAS, San Francisco will continue to be a haven amid external forces that threaten the civil rights and immigrant protections of Latin Americans; and

WHEREAS, This year, the Latin@ community has shown immense resilience through continued contribution to the nation's economy and an enduring celebration of their vibrant culture despite attacks on their very right to exist; and

WHEREAS, Latin@ Heritage Month is more than a remembrance of independence but a motivation toward the current and future fight for justice; and now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby declares September 15 through October 15, 2025, as "Latin@ Heritage Month" in the City and County of San Francisco; and, be it;

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors will continue to support and to uplift Latin@ communities in achieving equal rights and equitable outcomes through investments, resources, fair representation, and leadership opportunities.
