Resolution accepting the African American Arts and Cultural District's Cultural History, Housing, and Economic Sustainability Strategy Report (CHHESS) under Administrative Code, Section 107.5.

WHEREAS, On May 18, 2018, the City and County of San Francisco ("City") enacted Ordinance No. 126-18, which added Administrative Code, Chapter 107 to create a process for the establishment of cultural districts in the City to acknowledge and preserve neighborhoods with unique cultural heritage; and

WHEREAS, Administrative Code, Section 107.3 sets forth a list of established Cultural Districts (as defined in Administrative Code, Section 107.1) of the City and County of San Francisco: Japantown, Calle 24 (Veinticuatro) Latino Cultural District, SoMa Pilipinas – Filipino Cultural Heritage District, Compton's Transgender Cultural District, and the Leather and Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer (LGBTQ) Cultural District, African American Arts and Cultural District; Castro Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, and Queer (LGBTQ) Cultural District, and Sunset Chinese Cultural District; and

WHEREAS, Administrative Code, Section 107.5 requires the Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development ("MOHCD") to prepare a Cultural History, Housing, and Economic Sustainability Strategy ("CHHESS") Report for each Cultural District following the process set forth in Section 107.4(b)(5)-(7); and

WHEREAS, Under Administrative Code, Section 107A.2, the CHHESS Report for the African American Arts and Cultural District (the "District") shall include the following: 1) a demographic and economic profile of the District, including past, current, and future trends; analyze and record the tangible and intangible elements of the District's cultural heritage;

identify areas of concern that could inhibit the preservation of the District's unique culture; and propose legislative, economic, and other solutions and strategies to support the District; 2) discuss or incorporate the findings and recommendations of City departments; and 3) recommendations and input from the African American Arts and Cultural District Community Advisory Committee, and spearhead a community engagement process with residents, businesses, and workers in the District, to develop the strategies and plans that will preserve and enhance the culture of the District; and

WHEREAS, MOHCD, in partnership with the African American Arts and Cultural District, the Office of Economic and Workforce Development, the Planning Department, and the Arts Commission, designed the District's CHHESS Report to be a living, evolving framework of strategies—not a static report, and City departments may use the CHHESS Report as a roadmap for understanding the needs and priorities of the African American Arts and Cultural District; and

WHEREAS, Administrative Code, Sections 107.4(b)(7) and 107A.2(b) requires MOHCD to prepare and submit the CHHESS Report for the District to the Board of Supervisors, a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 250833, and is incorporated herein by reference; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, The Board of Supervisors hereby accepts the Cultural, History, Housing, and Economic Sustainability Strategy Report for the African American Arts and Cultural District submitted by MOHCD.
