WHEREAS, The Society remains an anchor institution in San Francisco, partnering with local organizations to shelter the unhoused, protect the rights of immigrants, and respond to pressing social needs through both grassroots activism and public advocacy; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors declares October 26, 2025, as First Unitarian Universalist Society of San Francisco Day in the City and County of San Francisco; and, be it
